

Level Two Online Sewing and Pattern Drafting Classes



BASIC SEWING/CONSTRUCTION 2:

Learn more of the special techniques that top designers use in their clothing construction. You'll begin with learning the three major hand stitches, how to correctly use a thimble and needle, then progress to more pocket construction. You'll also begin the side pocket in this class and will complete it in the next class of Clothing Construction 3. It's highly recommended to take the Pattern Drafting 2 at the same time.

Your materials list will be provided on the first day of class. (Supplies are not included.) You'll need a sewing machine next to your internet-ready computer. For more information, you may contact Mr. Stiles by e-mail at ewsacademy1802@ewsacademy.org.

March 26 - April 23 (five one-hour sessions, one per week.) Prerequisite: Sewing/Tailoring Class 1

Tuition: \$60

FIRST — Introduction of the use of the thimble and needle. We will begin our first 2 hand stitches: Overcast and Baste.

SECOND — In this class, we will start and complete the last hand stitch the Half Back. We will begin our second pocket the Quarter Top.

THIRD — We will complete the Quarter Top pocket and start marking the material for the Side pocket. (the third pocket)

FOURTH — We will start the Side pocket.

FIFTH — This class we will complete the Side pocket. Pocket placement will be demonstrated and explained.

PATTERN DRAFTING 2: (pattern making)

Continue learning more advanced formulas to draft professional patterns from beginning to end for Ready-to-Wear and Custom garments. Used by all of the top European and Domestic designers of the world. You will continue with procedures used to help you improve and complete your patterns. It's highly recommended to take the Sewing/Tailoring 2 when taking Pattern Drafting 2.

A materials list will be provided on the first day of class. (Supplies are not included.) You'll also have the option of continuing with Clothing Construction 3 and Pattern Drafting 3.

March 26 - April 23 (five one-hour sessions, one per week.) Prerequisite: Sewing/Tailoring Class 1.

Tuition: \$60

FIRST SESSION — We will begin the front for the quarter scale Pant pattern.

SECOND SESSION — We will continue with the drafting of front pant pattern.

THIRD SESSION — We will complete the front of the pant pattern. Next, we will start the draft for the back of the pant pattern.

FOURTH SESSION — During this class we will finish the back of the pant pattern.

FIFTH SESSION — In this class we will learn to add the placket, waistband, seam allowance, outlets and the hem. (Pant draft changes will be demonstrated and explained.)
